Add this information to your poster to help teach others. Try to make your poster as eye-catching and colourful as you can!

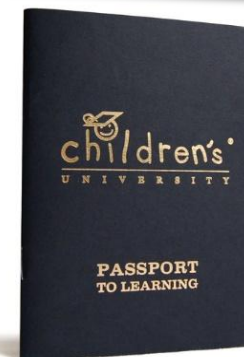
